

Please use the following measurements for your swatch so that Janice can apply your numbers to make your specific pattern sheet that you will take home with you.

The st and row measurements will be taken from 40 stitches and 60 rows. To get an accurate measurement, make your swatch at least 60 stitches wide (30 right and 30 left) and 80 rows long. Cast on with waste and knit 10 rows or more if you wish. Change to main yarn and knit 30 rows. On this row mark the st 21 right and 21 left. Knit the other 30 rows. Change back to waste yarn and knit 10 or so more rows. Bind off. Block the swatch as the yarn needs. If you plan to wash your garment, wash and dry your swatch the same as you would for the garment.
