- Date: Saturday and Sunday, October 18 and 19, 2008
- Place: Stacy Furniture, 1900 Main St. (just south of 114), Grapevine, Texas
- Format: Hands-On Knitting and Lecture
You will be knitting a small garment to learn the techniques for a sideways knit sweater. *Optionally* you can take home a fully grafted pattern so you can make a “real” sweater. This will require a swatch (blocked, washed and any other steps you normally use for your swatches) using this st and row count. Since this garment can be knitted on any gauge machine, use the yarn for the swatch you are want the sweater knitted from.

Bring the following:

- § Your single bed machine (any gauge) and a stand or table (Assistance will be provided with loaded and unloading if you need help. There is an elevator and you may use the loading zone.)
- § Machine features must include method to do short rowing
- § Yarn (small quantity) suitable for stockingette and for your size machine (Recommend an acrylic firm twist and cotton can grow so it’s not the best choice)

Homework:

- § Practice stockingette using yarn you are bringing to class to determine the best tension or stitch size
- § Swatch for optional pattern
- § Check out your machine, clean and oil it and be sure the sponge bar is in good shape.

Mattress Stitch Seams, knit and purl side	Rehanging
Use of multiple WY cast ons and knitting rag	Bottom Bands
Calculations to make the sweater	Minimal Discussion on Fit
